Submitting ISTE Assignments on Chalk & Wire

To that end the Education Department has required that all teacher education candidates create an ISTE portfolio in Chalk and Wire. The uploaded class assignments demonstrate how they have met the ISTE Standards for Level One, a requirement for admittance into the Education Department.

Directions for Submitting Class Assignments to the ISTE Portfolio on Chalk and Wire:

1. Log on to Chalk & Wire and open your ISTE portfolio.
(Portfolios→ISTE Portfolio)
2. Select the standard that you are required to submit. Each assignment has been aligned to a specific standard. See the ISTE Portfolio Outline if you are unsure as to which standard to choose.
3. Convert assignment to a PDF and upload assignment.
4. Write a brief description of the assignment.
5. State class, standard, and how the assignment meets the standard. For example, “In Ed 220, Standard 1c is met by...”
6. Please spell check before submitting!
7. Click the green submit button on the top right of the page.
8. On the drop down menu, **select ISTE Portfolio. Do NOT select the name of a professor.** (As you begin typing this, it will show up as a drop-down.) Click it and submit!
